LADY CHESTERFIELD broke sharp, set a moderate pace, drew off to mid stretch then just lasted late. RINELLA BAY stalked the pace inside to the stretch, angled to the middle of the track then finished well late to just miss. QUINCY LEE was well placed but lacked a strong late response. MOLLY MALONE was blocked inside to upper stretch but made up minor ground once clear. WHAT HAPPENS made a four wide bid into the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. SANDCASTLE chased to mid stretch then weakened. BEATING THE ODDS was no factor. SISTER GRACEFUL showed little. AVA AGAIN failed to menace. SEA GULL'S HARBOR was through early.
