Footnotes

LEIPZIG was unhurried early, looped five wide through the second turn then rallied past the leaders from the outside through the furlong grounds to be along in time. SCHOOL HOUSE stalked the leaders for more than a half, bid after five furlongs to gain a short lead into the furlong grounds but weakened late while besting the rest. BIRDWAY dueled to mid stretch then gave way. DISTORTED APPEAL was hung wide in the early stages, raced close up into the stretch but had no rally. COTURNIX raced evenly. HERE COMES MIKEY passed tiring rivals. HIGH BAR vied for the lead into the second turn then faded. FROGTOWN was no factor. TACTICAL STING showed little.
