LUCKY LEWIS was well handled controlling the issue and was put to a hard drive to hold off the challenge of VALLEY STREAM in the final furlong. VALLEY STREAM raced just outside the winner and loomed boldly through the stretch but couldn't get up. FORECON was well placed just off the pace then gained well late to close the gap. GALLICO, unhurried early, moved up outside rivals on the far turn then needed more. POUND FOOLISH failed to threaten. IT'S TIME TO REIGN attended the pace for six furlongs then tired. TRUE TEST saved ground to little avail.
