HENNIE'S SONG broke sharp, was well rated setting a moderate pace, drifted wide out of the second turn then dropped back inside when clear in the furlong grounds, was roused once left handed then shown the whip to prove best. LADYECHO stalked the pace inside to upper stretch then swung to the middle of the track and was up for the place late. COQUETTISH stalked the pace in hand, bid out of the second turn, was carried out a bit by the winner then after swinging back inside that one, failed to respond. MT. KOBLA was checked and steadied along for six furlongs while boxed then failed to gain once clear. HOLIDAY RUNNER failed to menace.
