LIKE AN EAGLE stalked the pace inside for three furlongs, angled out three wide to go after the leader leaving the turn then rallied past that one through the furlong grounds to be along in time. MINER MISTAKE dueled past mid stretch before hanging late and was second best. LA VENGANSA made a middle move to upper stretch but failed to sustain that rally. COURTING WISDOM dueled for a half then faded. HIDDEN BAY chased for a half then came up empty. SARATOGA SEVEN trailed.
