**Footnotes**

GHAZA RUN was void of early speed, made a four wide middle move to contention after five furlongs then wore down CARNIE'S SECRET in the final strides. CARNIE'S SECRET duelled for five furlongs, drew off leaving the second turn to hold a comfortable lead a furlong out but weakened late and just failed to last. FOLLIES DANCER was shuffled back from the inside into the first turn, chased the early pace, bid three wide into the second turn but couldn't stay with CARNIE'S SECRET and weakened under pressure. MAYBE ME passed tiring rivals. CASTELLI'S DANCE raced evenly. RUMBA JAZZ duelled inside to the second turn then stopped.
