### Footnotes

HE'S A KNOCKOUT broke sharp to gain a clear early lead, was well rated setting a moderate pace then drew off well when called upon leaving the second turn and was ridden out to prove clearly best. MARCIANO pulled hard while boxed and in traffic early, made a middle move to be closest to the winner out of the second turn but couldn't collar that one while easily second best. BEAU'S SURPRISE was well placed for six furlongs but had no rally. RUNSPASTUM raced evenly. BASEBALL CHAMPION showed little. BURNING ROMA was steadied along inside MARCIANO into the first turn, saved ground but was not a threat. FIRST AMENDMENT stopped.
