EMPIRE CALLER was well placed close to the pace, moved to the lead on the far turn then drew off under a mild drive. FAST JOE prompted the pace from the outset then was under a long drive to save second. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE circled rivals into the stretch then was outfinished for the place. CLASSIC ROCK STAR failed to menace passing tiring rivals in the stretch. ULTIMATE X. moved closer leaving the backstretch then flattened out. BROTHERS OUTLAW broke sharp to dispute the pace then tired. WHITE TIE N' TAILS showed little. ARCHIVE was used up vying for the early lead.
