HEROIC PURSUIT ducked out at the start, saved ground setting the pace and fought it out gamely. SUCH TIME AS THIS moved closer into the far turn then finished willingly. TANIVAN was outrun early then responded well in the drive. GOLD RECORD moved up along the inside on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. KEEP IT A SECRET moved up around rivals leaving the far turn then needed more. ARTHURS APPEAL was checked on heels at the top of the stretch. TIGRESS SEVEN prompted the early pace outside rivals and tired. INDIAN LEGEND prompted the early pace then tired and was eased through the stretch.
