Weight; 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over in 2005 allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2005, 5 lbs.; two races at a mile or over, 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Trophy to the winner. Closed Saturday, June 18th, 2005 with 26 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

DYNAMIST was unhurried early then moved up from the outside on the far turn, gained the lead near the top of the stretch and shook clear then held GRAT safe in the final furlong. GRAT, unhurried early moved up around rivals on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. TOLL TAKER was unhurried early, rallied outside rivals into the stretch then couldn't appreciably gain on the top two and finished evenly. RUTLEDGE BALLADO stalked the early pace, moved to the lead completing six furlongs then faded in the drive. MORE FOR ME was well placed just off the early pace then had little when called upon. LUCKY SLEVIN broke alertly and saved ground setting the early pace then tired. Portable inner rail set at 15 feet.
