ROWDY made a middle move in traffic, was blocked and forced to wait through the second turn and into the stretch, angled out four wide to gain clear racing room in the furlong grounds then ran down the leader in the final strides. ARISTOCRATIC LADY stalked the pace for six furlongs, bid outside the leader through the furlong grounds to gain the lead late but was caught near the wire. HAY CHEIF made a middle move inside, angled out five wide in the furlong grounds and was gaining ground outside late. BEAU'S TRIP chased the leader for six furlongs, bid into the stretch to gain a clear lead then hung late. LUCREZIA was well placed but failed to respond. ROYAL WAVE was fractious at the gate then showed little. PENUMBRA MOON set a slow pace to the stretch then weakened. POWER DU JOUR was no factor. The portable inner rail was set at 15 feet.
