WHEELS UP AT NOON saved ground racing close up along the inside, came out for the drive then ran down the leader a sixteenth mile out. PORT CLYDE was well handled setting the pace while saving ground and was not quite good enough to withstand the winner. REBEL YELLER prompted the pace racing two abreast and lacked the needed closing response. DINNER IN ODEM, never far back, responded well in the drive to close the gap. DIPLOMATIC CHARM made a run from the outside into the far turn then needed more in the drive. EVERYMAN showed little. VISTA MOON was in motion and unprepared for the start. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the start. Portable inner rail set at 15 feet.
