TRUE TO A POINT was void of speed for a half, swung six wide out of the turn then rallied past the leaders through the furlong grounds to gain the lead prevailed late. INDIABONITA showed no early speed, settled after a half then closed with a rush late. ROCK 'N' ROLL GAL chased throughout but was outkicked late. WACHACHA was well placed but lacked a late response. ALLY BEAR was well placed to mid stretch then gave way. THE PIA ANGEL set a fast pace into the final furlong then weakened. OASIS THE JAK stopped. DICED N SLICED was no factor.
