SPANISH CRYSTAL broke sharp, set a solid pace early, drew off to a commanding lead after six furlongs then showed strong stamina to prove best in the drive. ALWAYS A PLEASURE made a middle move then bested the rest. MYOSITIS SURVIVOR was well placed but failed to respond. GOVERNMENT BAILOUT tried to split rivals in the turn but lacked room and was forced to take up. MY SWEET THUNDER raced evenly. JAKE'S GOLD showed little and was vanned off. JIVE PARTNER stopped. Following a stewards inquiry and claim of foul by the rider of GOVERNMENT BALLOUT against MYOSITIS SURVIVOR for interference in the second turn no change was made in the order of finish.
