GOING TO MARKET moved up between rivals on the far turn to engage for the lead completing six furlongs, drifted out in the stretch and bumped rival in the final furlong then prevailed. EL SEASON circled horses on the far turn, was bumped in the final furlong then couldn't get up. UPPER AFLEET moved up menacingly on the far turn then lacked the needed closing kick. ET AL broke sharp to set the pace to the far turn then faded in the drive. WHEREISJOHNSHOUSE circled rivals on the far turn to loom boldly then faded in the drive. ROBYNHOOD prompted the pace then weakened. CAROL'S JIMMY broke alertly to be forwardly placed then weakened. COMPATRIOT tired. YES PAPI YES showed little.
