LOTTA IRISH was off a step slowly and moved closer into the stretch then closed along the inside rail and got up in the late stages. THE TEA CUPS was well placed close to the pace and gradually closed the gap. TAKE IT INSIDE quickly went to the front to set the pace, shook loose in upper stretch then was not quite good enough. ROLLING RATE responded well in the drive to close the gap. PENTHOUSE PARTY, never far back, rallied mildly in the stretch. MEG'S ANGEL lacked the needed rally. HENIN showed little. TWO HEARTS IN ONE prompted the pace racing two abreast then weakened. MIDNIGHT EXCHANGE tired from her early effort.
