BUCKEYE WONDER was boxed in along the inside into the far turn then moved through between rivals for the drive, ran down the leader in deep stretch and edged clear. GRAN CESARE (ARG) stalked the leader then engaged that one after a half mile, drew clear then was not good enough in the final furlong. OUR PEAK was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap. GENERAL JUMBO (GB) moved up between rivals on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. LEARNING moved up menacingly on the far turn then needed more in the stretch. MAGICAL GEM moved closer into the far turn then faded in the drive. HARBOR MASTER broke alertly to set the early pace and tired. PLEASE THE CROWD was forwardly placed to the far turn then had nothing left. Portable inner rail set at 25 feet.
