DUG IN was unhurried early, circled horses on the far turn then was bumped in the final furlong and got up late. EXCELLENT SOLDIER, well placed close, collared the leader in upper stretch then drifted out to bump with the winner and was caught late. BUDDY'S SONG broke alertly to dispute the pace and gave way grudgingly. LATER GATER moved up along the inside on the far turn and finished willingly. TACTICAL STING broke slowly then failed to threaten. QUIET MONK raced in traffic between horses around the far turn. VEER lacked a rally. LOFTY BANNER moved up closer outside rivals into the far turn then weakened in the drive. ASIAN STORM disputed the pace then tired. KING DARIUS showed little. A claim of foul by the rider of EXCELLENT SOLDIER against the winner for interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
