TRICKMEISTER broke sharp, set a slow pace, came into the stretch holding a narrow lead, drifted in a bit in the furlong grounds before being straightened then shook clear again late under strong handling. NOT ABROAD was void of early speed, advanced four wide out of the second turn then finished willingly along the outside late. COLIZEO was boxed inside early, was shuffled back inside in the second turn, started to swing outside the leader then altered course and dropped to the rail, was forced to steady when in tight leaving the furlong marker then swung back over the heels of the winner before weakening late. REGAL WARRIOR was void of early speed, looped four wide through the second turn to bid into the stretch then weakened in the drive. LAUS DEO raced close up early, bid after five furlongs then flattened out. WILDCAT LAKE stopped. BROKE BY NOON showed little. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the stretch run before the results were declared official.
