BLIND LUCK broke a step slow, was a bit slow to find her best stride, made a four wide middle move to contention then closed with a rush five wide to be up in the final stride. HAVRE DE GRACE chased the leader from the outset, moved up outside that one to press the issue out of the second turn, gained a short lead inside the final furlong then was just caught on the wire. DERWIN'S STAR broke sharp, set a moderate pace past mid stretch then weakened late. NO SUCH WORD was well placed, angled to the middle of the track out of the second turn but lacked a strong late response. WORSHIP THE MOON was well placed to the second turn then gave way. CALYPSO QUEEN bobbled at the break and was no factor. LISTEN IN was through early.
