MISS SARA TOGA was well placed from the outset, moved four wide through the second turn to challenge for and gain a clear lead then prevailed late under steady handling. DOYENNE never far back, was steadied along while boxed through the second turn, angled outside in the drive and was gaining but too late. CROSSANO made a five wide middle move, bid leaving the second turn to pose a threat then hung late. SKIRT THE WIND eased back off the early pacesetter, raced behind the first flight then was boxed and lacked clear racing room from the three eighths pole to upper stretch then couldn't gain once clear. QUEEN CAYMAN made a middle move then failed to sustain that rally. SASSAFRAS SLEW passed tiring rivals. PIPE WOMAN dueled to the upper stretch then weakened. TEJANA RENEE was no factor. CRISTAL MIST dueled for six furlongs and faded. REGAL BROAD was through after a half. MARY'SDIXIEMELODY trailed. The portable inner rail was set out 15 feet.
