YES IT'S THE TRUTH made an inside middle move, got through along the inside then was up for the place late. S K R'S SPARTAN broke sharp, set a fast pace under good handling then just weakened late. MAN IN GREY was well placed but lacked a strong late response. SIR SILVER FOX chased into the stretch then weakened. CAYMAN CONDO raced evenly. CASUAL was through after a half. FANCY RUNNER trailed.
