TODAY'S MAN was boxed in along the inside rail into and around the far turn, swung out behind horses in upper stretch and closed with good energy to win going away with something left. REHOBOTH moved up between rivals on the far turn, loomed boldly a furlong out then was not good enough. ROCK LOBSTER moved up menacingly completing six furlongs then faded in the final furlong. THEY'RE LATE moved to the inside when clear early to set the pace then weakened in the drive. MY CRUSADER moved up around rivals into the far turn then had little left for the drive. MAKAAAN stalked the early pace saving ground then tired.
