GRAZIANO was unhurried early, moved up four wide around rivals into the stretch to challenge and proved best under steady pressure. FARE CIELO moved up menacingly between rivals into the stretch then was second best. FIESTA TEXAS broke alertly to set the pace then weakened in the drive and saved third. OUR SECOND FITZ moved closer along the inside around the far turn then flattened out in the drive. DESOLATOR failed to threaten. BIG SMOOTH showed little.
