ANCIENT ROME dueled from the outset, shook clear into the furlong grounds then was sharply roused to just last late. SWORD TRICK raced close up early, bid three wide after three furlongs, held on well when the winner shook clear then came back on again late outside. RECONSTRUCTION raced boxed for a half then failed to respond when clear in the drive. COP A TUDE angled outside after a half but could gain only minor ground. WON THE WAR raced evenly. ARTURIUS was shuffled back after a quarter. DANE'S WINCHESTER was used up setting the pace for a half.
