LIGHTS ON chased the early leader, bid through the second turn to move clear into the stretch then drew off steadily through the final quarter under a moderate hand ride. TROLLETTE was unhurried early, made a middle move to contention after five furlongs then was up for the place late while no match for the winner. NOT A PROBLEM made a quick move to contention through the second turn to loom a threat after six furlongs then flattened out under pressure. GRISHAM made a middle move but failed to sustain that rally. LONG CHUN chased to the quarter pole then gave way. CARLY POOH set the pace to the second turn then weakened. HERE COMES CHERRY was through early. NATASHA'S RENO was well placed for six furlongs then came up empty. LUCKY FOURTEEN was no factor. SATIN DOLLY trailed.
