XCHANGER stalked the pace, moved to the lead under urging completing six furlongs then was under strong handling to draw clear and hold off the challenge of KING OF THE ROXY. KING OF THE ROXY, well placed just off the pace, moved up from the outside on the far turn and responded willingly in the drive. PHONE HOME broke sharp to set the pace while saving ground and gave way grudgingly. LONGLEY moved up smartly along the inside through the backstretch to be a factor to the stretch then flattened out in the drive. HAL'S MY HOPE was in close quarters between rivals in the run to the first turn, remained a forward factor to the far turn then weakened. REPTILIAN SMARTS was fractious in the gate then failed to threaten. POINT BLAKE was checked on heels in tight quarters in the run to the first turn then was an early factor and tired.
