QUIDNASKRA broke alertly, was well handled setting the pace then was put to a hard drive in the final furlong to prevail. MINKIE was blocked along the inside rail into and around the far turn, got clear in upper stretch and finished gamely along the rail. RHUM, well placed inside, drifted out in the final furlong and held third. DREAMS moved up in traffic around the far turn then finished evenly while drifting out a bit in the final furlong. FINAL ONE raced within striking distance outside rivals and lacked the needed closing bid. MARIA'S TIARA prompted the pace to the stretch and faded in the drive. SECRET DESTINY was blocked around the far turn and into the stretch. LET'S CANOODLE, well placed just off the pace, weakened in the drive. Portable inner rail set out 25 feet.
