AWFULLY SMART was unhurried early then inched up outside rivals into the far turn to engage for the lead completing six furlongs, drew clear in upper stretch and widened his advantage under brisk urging into the final furlong. AH DAY, well placed just off the early pace, moved up outside rivals on the far turn then was no match for the winner in the stretch. LITTLE CLIFF bobbled slightly at the start, was well placed racing close up along the inside then bested the others. IRISH GENTLEMAN prompted the pace two wide, gained a short lead on the far turn then weakened in the drive. THrong broke alertly, saved ground setting the pace for nearly six furlongs then weakened in the drive. HOW'S YOUR HALO bobbled at the start, raced close up along the inside early then tired.
