CRIMSON PRIDE set a moderate pace, drew off to mid stretch then held sway. FOOLISH COMMENT was boxed early, got through into the second turn then swung off the rail in the drive but couldn't gain while drifting out. TRAPPIST MONK looped well wide out of the second turn then made up minor ground late while drifting in. ROMAN FROLIC pressed the pace from the outset, bid in the second turn then weakened in the drive before steadying late. MR. CONDUCTOR made a mild middle move then gave way then also steadied late. HERE COMES MIKEY was no factor. FERBER trailed. There was a stewards inquiry held into the stretch run but no change in the order of finish was made.
