Footnotes

ISLAND SAND was unhurried for six furlongs, made a three wide middle move to contention through the second turn then challenged outside the leader through the furlong grounds and shook that one off late to draw away under pressure. TWO TRAIL SIOUX was away alertly to set a moderate pace, resisted the winner through the furlong grounds then weakened late while best of the rest. PERSONAL LEGEND was void of early speed, advanced through the second turn then swung five into the stretch and made up some ground through the late stages. FRIEL'S FOR REAL split rivals to move to striking distance out of the second turn but failed to sustain that rally. STRATEGY stalked the pace inside for a mile then weakened. SAINTLINESS chased the leader from the outset, attempted unsuccessfully to collar that one after seven furlongs then faded in the drive. INDIA HALO (ARG) passed tiring rivals. ISOLA PIU BELLA (CHI) was unruly in the starting gate, raced well placed to the quarter pole then came up empty. SILMARIL made an outside middle move then faltered. BECKY IN PINK was no factor and was not hard pressed late. RACING LUCK stopped and was not pressed late.
