### Footnotes

LIFE AT TEN took command right at the start, coming in slightly after the break, set a slow pace under confident rating then slowly pulled away through the final quarter mile while roused twice left handed and vigorously ridden to the wire. MISS SINGHSIX (IRE) was unhurried early, looped four wide through the second turn moving to contention then rallied through the furlong grounds to secure the place and be best of the rest. FUNNY MOON raced inside to the stretch, angled to the middle of the track to be closest to the winner into the furlong grounds but failed to respond when called upon. MILWAUKEE APPEAL stalked the pace for seven furlongs, bid three wide leaving the second turn then flattened out. MISS MATCH (ARG) chased to the quarter pole then gave way. MILLION SELLER was shuffled back at the start then trailed.
