PLYMOUTH SQUARE raced three abreast with the pace and fought it out gamely to the end. QUIET FAVORITE vied for the lead between horses then faded in the final furlong. MISTER DISH saved ground disputing the pace then weakened in the drive. FIVESIXSEVEN lacked a rally. HORSESHOE LAKE showed little. HARLEY'S WISEGUY tired from his early effort then was being eased up in deep stretch.
