AMOURETTE broke alertly, was well handled setting the pace then was put to a hard drive in the final furlong to prevail. AIGLONNE, never far back, advanced in traffic into and around the far turn then worked her way clear in upper stretch and closed gamely. KRISADA, well placed just off the pace, lacked the needed closing kick. MOONLADY (GER) raced in closest pursuit of the pacesetter and lacked the needed closing bid. CAVEAT'S SHOT, unhurried early while saving ground, responded well in the drive. SEATTLE BAY saved ground stalking the pace and lacked the needed stretch response. ZENITH lacked the needed rally. NEW ASSEMBLY (IRE) was steadied between rivals into the first turn, raced within striking distance and faded in the drive. GUITAR showed little. Temporary inner rail set at 0 feet.
