COUNTRY BE GOLD had a perfect trip, racing unhurried back of a pace duel for six furlongs, rallied three wide out of the second turn then shook off MR. O'BRIEN leaving the furlong grounds to win going away under brisk handling. MR O'BRIEN (IRE) dueled two wide from the outset, moved clear out of the second turn then had his rider lose his whip in mid stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. CITY SHARPSTER eased back from the inside early, angled outside to vie for the lead into the backstretch then continued well to upper stretch before giving way. HUNTER B. raced evenly. HALO KRIS was through early.
