RADIO RELAY broke sharp to gain the early lead, shook clear into the second turn while setting a fast pace then drew off when roused after six furlongs and was kept to pressure to prove clearly best. COMMODORE WAY made a middle move to the stretch, angled to the middle of the track but couldn't gain on the winner while second best. TEMPLE RUN was void of speed for six furlongs then lodged a mild rally late. IT'S NEVER TO LATE pressed the pace for five furlongs then faded. SWORD PLAY was through after a half. FURRIARIAT showed little.
