Such a race of \$30,000 since April 23, 9 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). Field will be limited to twelve starters. Preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (respective of sex). Closed Sunday, July 9, 2000 with 29 nominations.

Footnotes

THREE WONDERS stalked the early pace removed from the inner rail, rallied outside FIELD CAT through mid stretch then drew clear through the late stages while ridden out. FIELD CAT sprinted clear early, drew off before a half then resisted the winner when challenged to the late stages before hanging while best of the rest. DAWN OF THE CONDOR made a strong four wide middle move to contention but failed to sustain that rally in the stretch. HANDSOME TRICK was boxed through the second turn but had no rally when angled out in the clear. POLISH MINER saved ground in a striking position but had no response in the drive. UNRECORDED chased to the second turn then faded. BLAZE AND BLUES made a four wide middle move but couldn't gain after six furlongs and was under only mild encouragement in the final quarter. YEOWZER made a three wide middle move then stopped. The portable inner rail was set out zero feet.
