LU RAVI was away alertly to gain the early lead, was patently rated while setting a moderate pace, shook off SILVERBULLETLADY leaving the second turn then was under a mild hand ride to maintain a safe margin late over TAP TO MUSIC. TAP TO MUSIC bumped with SALUTELOOT at the break, tucked in behind the leader shortly after the start, was boxed through the second turn then angled off the rail and finished willingly but couldn't collar the winner while best of the rest. SILVERBULLETDAY was four wide into the first turn, pressed the winner from the three eighths pole to the stretch then weakened in the drive. PROUD OWNER was void of early speed then made a mild gain late. HER HALO prompted the pace to the quarter pole then gave way. GANDRIA was off a bit slow and was no factor. SALUTELOOT bumped with TAP TO MUSIC at the break, raced close up for six furlongs then faded. BATUKA was also off a bit slow then failed to menace.
