EARTHA (IRE) saved ground early, moved through between rivals on the far turn then closed gamely to get up in time. PAR GOLFER broke alertly to dispute the pace and was caught at the wire in a sharp effort. CROOM saved ground early, rallied between rivals on the far turn then closed gamely to get up for third. GONE TO GREECE stalked the pace, engaged for the lead into the far turn then was not quite good enough late. MINES IN GEAR was forced wide on the far turn. SMOOTH SLEW saved ground disputing the pace to the far turn and weakened. BALLYMENA DANCER showed nothing. ALWAYS ON THE GO, forwardly placed for six furlongs, tired. MEADOW TERN showed nothing. KARITSAS PUNCH got out around both turns. Portable inner rail set at 0 feet.
