DJOKOVIC was void of early speed, angled outside in the drive then was best of the rest. STANDUP COMIC set a fast pace for five furlongs then weakened. MAXIMOSO was well placed to the stretch then gave way. CHINGLISH was through after a half. FUNFAHA failed to menace. ASHTONOFUN vied for the lead early then faded. SATURDAY AT TEN showed little.
