Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 at a mile or over in 1999 allowed 3 lbs.; \$90,000 at a mile or over in 1999, 5 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over in 1999, 7 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 9 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Field will be limited to twelve starters with preference to horses with total highest earnings. Trophy to the winner. Closed Sunday, July 11, 1999 with 27 nominations.

BRUSHED HALORY got in at the start and was quickly straightened to race within striking distance, was set down on the far turn and drove to the front in the final sixteenth mile. GOLD FROM THE WEST, well placed racing removed from the inside, was put to a drive on the final turn and gained the lead nearing the furlong pole then fought it out gamely. QUEEN'S WORD trailed to the stretch and closed willingly to get up late for third. LOEN SALT, away alertly, saved ground setting pace and gave way grudgingly. GOLDEN TEMPER, well placed close to the pace, had nothing when called upon.
