MISTER MEEHAN chased the leader early, bid outside that one into the stretch then after dueling to late, shook clear despite being bumped inside the final furlong. CROSS TOWN RIVAL broke alertly, set a strong pace for a half then resisted the winner before coming out to bump that one inside the final furlong while hanging and was second best. TIZNOW TRUE made a middle move but lodged only a mild late rally. MISUNDERESTIMATED was well placed just off the pace but weakened after a half. CATCH THE HUMOR passed tiring rivals. J DOUBLE F was no factor. HE'S A GMAN failed to menace. WILL I EVER showed little.
