### Footnotes

HERE FOR THE MUSIC looped four wide to challenge into the stretch, drifted in a bit in the drive then was all out to prevail late. MR. BARRON was inside to mid stretch then angled out five wide in the furlong grounds before closing fast late to just miss. GIBSON CREEK chased early, was boxed inside and behind rivals into the stretch then lacked racing room between rivals in the drive. HERECOMESTHE STORM chased inside, got through inside to lead between calls in the drive only to be outkicked late. IRISH LION made a middle move to be in striking position in the drive but lacked a strong late response. DIAMOND COUNTY set a moderate pace early, drifted out into the stretch then gave way. SUDDSY SUNDAY showed little. There was a stewards inquiry and claim of foul by the rider of GIBSON CREEK against the winner for interference in the stretch but the original order of finish was permitted to stand as posted.
