ZIGGLY raced just outside the leader, edged to the front on the far turn then was under strong handling to prevail. MAY WE DANCE made a run on the far turn then finished willingly to close the gap. PRECIOUS PRINCESS broke alertly to contest the pace and gave way grudgingly. JAUNTY GALE, never far back, rallied mildly. CORRENTINA, forwardly placed, lacked the needed response in the stretch. THE REAL FUTURE, well placed close to the pace, lacked the needed rally.
