### Footnotes

HOLD TRUE was never far back, bid three wide into the stretch then dueled through a long drive before getting up in the final strides. MIKEY JOE set a moderate pace, resisted gamely when challenged then continued gamely to the finish to just miss. MORE MOETION made a middle move to contention after six furlongs but failed to gain late. FIRST TRACKS (ARG) passed tiring rivals. OH MY GUINNESS also passed faders. ETAR stalked the pace early, bid in the second turn then flattened out. SOMBREADO was well placed to the stretch then gave way. SMARLEY was no factor. SCIP TOO MUCH rushed up to press the pace for five furlongs then stopped. PEACE OF MON bore out into the backstretch then was outdistanced after five furlongs.
