SPLendid SUNRISE, in close leaving the chute then in a bit of traffic on the backstretch, moved out on the far turn and closed to get up in the final furlong. ALL SPADES moved up quickly into contention leaving the backstretch, gained the lead on the far turn but couldn't contain the winner. LA SAMANNA saved ground early, came out for the drive and closed well. OUT OF SWEETS saved ground to the far turn, worked her way out and finished well. HOT DREAMS saved ground and was steadied in close quarters on the far turn. SWAN LAKE moved up menacingly into the final turn and faded in the drive. SOAP OPERA moved up to challenge on the final turn and weakened in the drive. TWISTINGANDTURNING saved ground setting the early pace and tired. Portable inner rail set out 25 feet.
