CONCORD'S MELODY broke alertly to control the issue and was under strong handling to turn back RUDE COYOTE in the final furlong. RUDE COYOTE moved up strongly from the outside into the stretch and lacked the needed closing bid. SUNNY STRIKE was in close along the inside early then closed well. RUNAGATE, outrun to the stretch, finished well along the inside. CLOUDY AFTERNOON saved ground pressing the winner to the stretch and faded. SECRET SHAMROCK failed to seriously menace. CHICKASAW ROAD showed early speed along the inside and tired. OH BABY OH BABY was outrun. Portable inner rail set out 25 feet.
