RHYTHMN MASTER was never far back, angled out four wide in the second turn then rallied past the leaders through the furlong grounds to be along in time. DEMPSEY pressed the pace from the outset, bid leaving the second turn to gain a short lead between calls then weakened in the final furlong while saving the place. CRITICAL ACCLAIM fanned six wide in the second turn then lodged a mild rally late. MARNESIA'S BIG BOY advanced to mid stretch then weakened. SINISTER raced evenly. WILD CAT MESA dueled to upper stretch then faded. SONG CYCLE showed little. POINT LOOKOUT stopped. DIXIE DECISION chased to the stretch then stopped.
