MAX'S PAL broke alertly to vie for the early lead, shook off NOT A CORGI leaving the furlong marker then was all out to last late over TUSCAN CHIEF. The latter raced well placed back of the battle for the early lead then finished stoutly late to just miss. TRENTINO fanned four wide leaving the turn and was steadily gaining late. KICK IT UP angled in after three furlongs and closed a gap late. NOT A CORGI disputed the pace to the furlong marker and hung late. COOPER CITY steadied between rivals entering the turn but failed to threaten. KNOCKOUT THE TRUTH was through early.
