SISTER SOUL was well placed for a half then was steadily gaining on the winner three wide through the late stages. NAJJMAH (GB) closed a gap too late. BREAK WITH STYLE passed tiring rivals. TIMELY PRESENCE dueled for a half then gave way. AUNT LYNNIE failed to menace. JANUARY ANGEL weakened gradually. REALIZATION was through early. AL'S BEST MISS was no factor. DOUBLE WAMMIE stopped.
